

Instructions for Preparing for Women's and Gender Studies Ph.D Entrance Examination, 2021-22

Applicants would be assessed to establish their critical and analytical abilities translated to research potential. We hope to converse with a number of disciplines and thus, familiarity with your primary discipline (if not Women's Studies or Gender Studies) is an advantage. Yet, familiarity and interest in issues of gender and society in general will be essential. This will be assessed through examining the candidate's familiarity with current debates within the Women's and Gender Studies. What is expected is an interdisciplinary orientation.

Important Instructions:

1. Candidates should bring a valid photo Identity proof and PhD entrance admit card for verification.
2. The duration of the written entrance exam will be 2 hours.
3. Total marks for entrance exam is 70 marks; 40 marks objective questions and 30 marks descriptive.
4. "Use BLACK/ BLUE ball point pen only" to mark the answer for MCQ.
5. For subjective answers, use any blue pen.
6. Mobiles & any Electronic gadget are not allowed in the room.
7. Applicants are required to bring the hard copy of the original Research Proposal submitted at the time of online application form and submit the hard copy before the examination begins. Candidates should clearly mention their **Application number and Form number** in first page of their proposal.
